SUMMARY

This enormous cabin is tucked under tall trees and will sleep your whole family while putting you close to some of Hocking's best activities. That's why it's #1 on the list.

PROS

This cabin puts you much closer to good hikes and activities (15-20 minutes away) than the other two places on the list. It's also the only one with eight private bedrooms. In fact, it will probably feel very large for your 19 family members because of the large-span ceiling in the great room, which warmly connects the living room area, the kitchen, and the upstairs loft with a massive A-shaped window with forest views. There's a playset for the kiddos right off the back deck, and once the kids go to bed the adults can sit around the fire pit or chill in the hot tub.

CONS

The only downsides I found are the "no pets" rule and the lack of a gas grill (they do have a charcoal one). They also do NOT have WiFi.

NEARBY ACTIVITIES

Hocking Hills is well-known for their outdoor attractions and natural areas. In my experience there the best hikes are Conkle's Hollow, Old Man's Cave, and Ash Cave. Old Man's Cave is the most popular but for good reason, so go early in the day. Ash Cave is a massive recess cave with a small waterfall. At Conkle's Hollow the adults can enjoy spectacular views from atop a 200-foot U-shaped cliff while the kids can stick to the Gorge Trail, which is beautiful in its own right.

There's not exactly noteworthy fine dining, but there are a number of little restaurants that offer reliable comfort food. If you're looking for more options then I'd suggest making the short drive to Logan where you'll get chain restaurants. That's also where you can stock up on groceries and beer (Walmart).

SUMMARY

Lots of outdoor space blends with a well-designed indoor arrangement to create a very spacious cabin that gives you access to 56-acres of trails, right out your back door.

PROS

A stunning master suite with a private loft and jacuzzi tub give this place some luxury. It also has a hot tub, fire pit, and game area for the kids (air hockey, billiards, etc.). The kitchen is very spacious so you're not knocking into other cooks. The indoor gathering areas will give your family plenty of room to hang out together, but if you need some time alone then go for a hike on some of the property's trails! The outdoor green space is also a nice plus (cornhole, frisbee, etc.).

They list having WiFi in the cabin but I wouldn't count on it being high speed.

CONS

Only having six private bedrooms is less than ideal, but there are is a fold-out couch in the loft and plenty of floor space if you just need to put an air mattress down.

No pets are allowed at this property either, and there's no gas grill (only charcoal). The only other downside is your need to drive 30+ minutes to get places like Old Man's Cave and Conkle's Hollow.

NEARBY ACTIVITIES

Compared to #1, this lodge is further away from the natural attractions that grace Hocking Hills. But it's extremely close to Logan in case you need to run into town, which may be desirable.

SUMMARY

This 6-bedroom cabin is in a private nature setting and gives you plenty of gathering space. It's closer to town than #1 but further away from hiking trails.

PROS

Even though this is listed as the #3 option it still has plenty going for it. It's a well-appointed cabin with plenty of gathering space (both inside and outside), a nice-sized kitchen, a pool table in the loft, and a game room in the basement for the kids to enjoy. It also has a fire pit and hot tub! They list having WiFi in the cabin but I wouldn't count on it being high speed. It's a little closer to the town of Logan than #1.

CONS

Only having six private bedrooms is less than ideal, but there are sleeping areas throughout the cabin. There's a full futon in the loft, a full futon in the solarium, and a day bed in the lower loft.

Having to drive 25-30 minutes to drive to most activities may not be attractive when hauling around 7 kids. Also, unfortunately this cabin does not allow pets. And there's no gas grill (only charcoal).

NEARBY ACTIVITIES

All the same Hocking area activities still apply here. Also, keep in mind that cell phone service could be spotty but I've heard Hocking Hills has improved in the last few years. Just plan accordingly.
